



Subject: Report upon the measures prescribed under "Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan (NMBA)" launched by Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.

In reference to the joint DO letter no. DP/7/2023-DP-I dated 06.08.2024 and subsequent reminder on 21.02.2025 from Secretary, Higher Education and Secretary, Social Justice and Empowerment (copies enclosed) on the subject mentioned above, a concept note was forwarded with the said DO letter in which a list of activities/ measures including constitution of "Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan Hostel Committee" had been proposed (Annexure-1).

The following activates/ measures has been taken so far from the committee constituted by the Dean, Student Affairs AIIMS Patna:

1. Formation of a Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan Hostel Committee at AIIMS Patna which has following members:

- 2. An annual schedule was prepared about the activities to ensure sensitization and awareness of the student's community, faculties and residents for the hostel, regarding substance use menace.
- 3. The awareness programs were conducted on regular basis to identify vulnerable students in terms of substance use and mental health related issues. A structure organised program was conducted during World Mental Health week 10<sup>th</sup> October 2024 related with the "Theme Suicidal Prevention and substance related behavior". There were also several activities conducted in this regard during the year 2024-25.
- 4. The committee have a collaborative mechanism with the enforcement agencies to ensure that the supply of Narcotic drugs from neighboring boundary areas/ slums/ hotspot etc. can be curbed. Thus, the student population remains in a safe and drug free environment. This collaborative approach aims to create a vigilant community, effectively combating drug peddling and illegal trafficking (alcohol & other illegal substances).
- It has proper referral & networking systems in liaison with other departments of AIIMS Patna for holistic management of patients including help line number in need.
- 6. The Committee also decided to merge with Mental Health Awareness Centre, as suggested by the competent authority with "Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan Hostel Committee". (Refer to file no. 200551 & letter no. AIIMS/Pat/Psy/2024/559 Dated 16.10.2024)
- 7. The place for the same was discussed among the members and finalized near the hostel area (Nearby Warden Office, BH).
